NHS EXPECTATIONS

These are National and School expectations to remain a member of National Honor Society. We will review how each member is doing each semester. If you do not meet expectations, you will be placed on probation for a marking period. If you do not remedy the situation in one marking period, you will be removed from our chapter.

YOU MUST:

- 1. Maintain a 3.5 GPA
- 2. Citizenship grades of 1's and 2's.
- 3. Miss no more than 2 meetings throughout the year.

Meetings are the 1st Tuesday of each month. (Second Tuesday if school is not in session during the first Tuesday.)

4. Help with tutoring within the school.

This includes attending Freshmen Cookies and Cram, as well as math lab or other tutoring in the school. You should complete at least 2 hours of tutoring each semester.

5. Participate in at least one chapter community service event each semester.

These events are put on by our chapter a few times each semester.

6. Complete 30 hours of community service each year.

This may include tutoring and chapter events. No more than 10 hours can be from the summer and the hours should be split between semesters. Example: 10 hours summer, 10 hours 1st semester, and 10 hours 2nd semester.

- 7. Adhere to the NHS Bylaws and School Policies.
- 8. Remain actively involved in at least one other school club, sport, or organization.
- 9. Earn 20 points per year in order to: continue as a member (junior to senior) or have the option of purchasing an honor cord to wear during the commencement ceremony if you are a senior.
- 10. Pay a one-time membership fee of \$20.

***Any disciplinary issues will be reviewed by faculty council to remain active.
