

Japanese II Test-Out Procedures

Registration

Students who have NEVER BEEN ENROLLED in Japanese II will be eligible to take the exam. Students interested in taking the Japanese II Test-Out need to be in at least the eighth grade. Register online using the link below. Students will be required to bring their student ID with them to the exam. Students who pass this exam will be awarded 1 world language credit on their high school transcript. The results of the test-out will not affect their grade point average.

Location: Holmes Middle School

Note: You will need access to headphones.

REGISTRATION is until Jan 11, 2023.

Test Components

The exam has two sections: a reading section and a listening section. Grammar and vocabulary questions are embedded in both sections.

Section	Length	Content
Listening	Level 1: 10 minutes	Various quasi-authentic audio listening texts with comprehension questions in English and related grammar/vocabulary questions in Japanese. All questions are multiple-choice.
	Level 2: 20 minutes	
Reading	Level 1: 20 minutes	Various quasi-authentic text readings with comprehension questions in English and related grammar/vocabulary questions in Japanese. All questions are multiple-choice.
	Level 2: 35 minutes
