

Letter Identification Activity



Dear Kindergarten Families,

If your child cannot already identify/read all 52 letters, here is a quick and easy activity to teach them the letters of the alphabet over the summer.

Directions:

- 1. Cut out the capital and lowercase letter tiles.*
- 2. Mix up all the letters.*
- 3. Ask your child to identify the letters.*
- 4. Put the letters they know in a re-sealable bag labeled, "Letters I Know."*
- 5. Put the letters they do not know yet in a re-sealable bag labeled, "Letters I Am Still Learning."*
- 6. Each day, have your child read to you all of the letters in the "Letters I Know" bag.*
- 7. Choose 1-2 letters every day from the "Letters I Am Still Learning" bag, teach them to your child, and move the new letters to the "Letters I Know" bag.*

If you do this quick activity daily during the summer, hopefully, by the first day of Kindergarten, your child will be able to identify all 52 letters! 😊
