



Good Afternoon LPS Parents and Staff,

We would like to update you on the LPS Return to Learn planning as we wrap up the week.

As you know, we presented the district's task force steering committee recommendations to the Board of the Education for review on July 27. The Board of Education, during its August 3 meeting, after thoughtful and careful consideration of feedback shared by parents and staff, requested that the district bring forth plans to adjust Safe Start September to include a fully remote start to the school year, in place of the ½ day option.

District planning teams assembled throughout this week and developed a remote Safe Start September learning plan for the Board to consider and discuss this coming Monday, August 10.

The Board is expected to vote on the revised proposal on Monday, August 10 during a virtual meeting which will begin at 6 p.m.
