SUBJECT: Summer Academic Employment Opportunity for Paraprofessionals 2022

(Deadline May 23, 2022)

Learning in L-Town is a supplemental intervention program that provides a variety of learning choices and will utilize federal grant funds for the summer of 2022. Students exiting grades K-8 are invited to participate based upon choice and the desire to continue to learn throughout the summer.

Conditions of Employment

Current Livonia Public Schools paraprofessionals will be given the first opportunity for employment. Paraprofessionals must have experience in the subject area for which they are applying. The K-grade 3 content will have heavy emphasis on early literacy skills to support reading at grade level by third grade. Apply only if you will be available for <u>all</u> workdays and the <u>entire</u> time period for the session or segment of the summer program for which you are applying. There will be no substitutes available.

The rate for the summer of 2022 will be \$25.00 per hour. This increased rate is due to the availability of time-limited Federal Funds.

Application deadline for summer employment opportunity is May 23, 2022, or until filled.

Descriptions of Positions for Learning in L-Town Summer Learning Opportunities

Staff can apply to work multiple positions throughout the summer.

- Reading and Mathematics Interventionist(s)
 - o Elementary or Middle School Instructional paraprofessionals who have training and experience with providing students with short, targeted interventions, both in academics and behavior
- Special Education Professional(s)
 - o Special Education paraprofessionals who can support students who have identified academic, behavioral or other needs
