

Chaperone Expectations

1. Stay with your group at all times, including time in the cabins. Students are told they must be with an adult at all times.
2. If a student needs to use the bathroom, the chaperone (and another student) will accompany the student to the nearest bathroom. Notify the other parent in your group, or the Howell Nature Center staff that you and the students are heading to the bathroom.
3. Be a cheerleader for your group. Be encouraging and helpful. Remind students to follow the Cooper Core 4 - Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Trustworthy, Be Caring.
4. Remind students to use good manners at mealtime and to pick up things that have fallen on the floor.
5. Smoking is not allowed at camp.
6. Any discipline problems or concerns that may arise at camp should be referred to a member of the Cooper staff or to the principal in attendance at camp. We have high standards of behavior for all students and we need your support in making sure our code of conduct is being followed at all times at camp. We can't fix it if we don't know about it so don't be afraid to ask for help.
